The SEE Program is an IMSLEC accredited program recognized by IDA for teaching phonological and phonemic awareness, sound-symbol correspondence, phonics, decoding and encoding, syllables, morphology, auditory discrimination and memory. SEE was written by Dr. Joyce S. Pickering of Shelton School of Dallas. May Center offers this national certification program through our partnership with Shelton. Successful completion of this course of study qualifies participants to take the national ALTA test and become a Certified Academic Language Practitioner.

54 hour course includes:
